Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How much is the cost per player?

- A:
 Tots and Mites: \$75/player
- Peewee division Midget Division(8th grade) \$100
- Additional family members are \$75 per player up to 4 family members.



Q: Are there any discounted rates for registration?

A: Yes! During the entire month of April, registrants will receive an Early Bird Discount of \$10 per registration. There is also a multi-player discount for families with more than one player. Financial aid is also available (see the Financial Aid Application on our website).

Q: When are tryouts?

A: CASA does not require tryouts to participate in recreational play.

Q: When are weekly practices?

A: Practices will be scheduled at the time and location by the volunteer team coach.

Q: When are the games played?

A: All games to be played on Saturday or Sunday. Tot and Mite Divisions often are primarily scheduled on Saturdays unless there is a weather cancellation or scheduling conflict.

Q: At what age can a player begin playing at CASA?

A: CASA programs begin at age 4 and continue through 14 for boys and 15 for girls. CASA establishes a starting and ending age matrix for each division for each fall season, which is available on our website.

Q: Can Club/Select Players play in CASA's recreational program?

A: CASA Bylaws allow up to four (4) players per team who have or are currently participating in Club/Select programs.

Q: Can my child play up a division if he/she is more skilled and can compete against older players?

A: CASA requires each player to participate in their appropriate age division.

Q: How do I register my child if he/she is a returning player?

A: Using the login and password from the previous CASA Registration, login at www.collinsvillesoccer.org once registration is open and proceed with the registration process.

Q: How do I register my child if he/she is a new player to CASA?

A: At www.collinsvillesoccer.org, click the Register tab. Then create a login and password use the CASA registration system. Begin registration by entering parent information followed by the player information.

Q: How do I register multiple players?

A: After registering the initial player, there will be an ADD PARTICIPANT tab that must be clicked. Then proceed with registering the additional player.

Q: How will I know if games are cancelled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances?

A: CASA will provide Live Updates through our Facebook page and alerts to our website. CASA also maintains the option to send out blast emails to all CASA members on our email list.

Q: What does my registration fee include?

A: Each CASA player will be provided a team jersey and team socks for game play.

Q: If my child loses his/her uniform, how do I get another?

A: Please contact the CASA Board either through our website or through the team coach, and CASA will contact its uniform supplier for any uniform issues. Parents/Guardians will be responsible for the cost of any uniform replacement, either due to uniform loss or inappropriate size choice at registration.

Q: I have an officiating complaint.

A: Please convey your concern to the team coach and have him/her speak to the CASA Referee Assignor at the CASA fields.

Q: Can my team practice at the CASA fields?

A: CASA teams are not allowed to practice at the field complex unless you are a Tot team or a team coached by a CASA Board member.

Q: I want to sign my child up this year, but on a different team. How do I do that?

A: When you register your child, please indicate in the "Special Comments" section that you would like your child to play on a different team.
